

## FINAL REPORT ON THE NATIONAL DIALOGUE ON THE QUADRENNIAL HOMELAND SECURITY REVIEW RELEASED

On February 1, 2010 the Department of Homeland Security submitted their first [Quadriennial Homeland Security Review](#) to Congress. A major component of this QHSR process was the extensive National Dialogue, hosted by the National Academy of Public Administration, that invited stakeholder input from across the country on key ideas and materials being developed by DHS.
